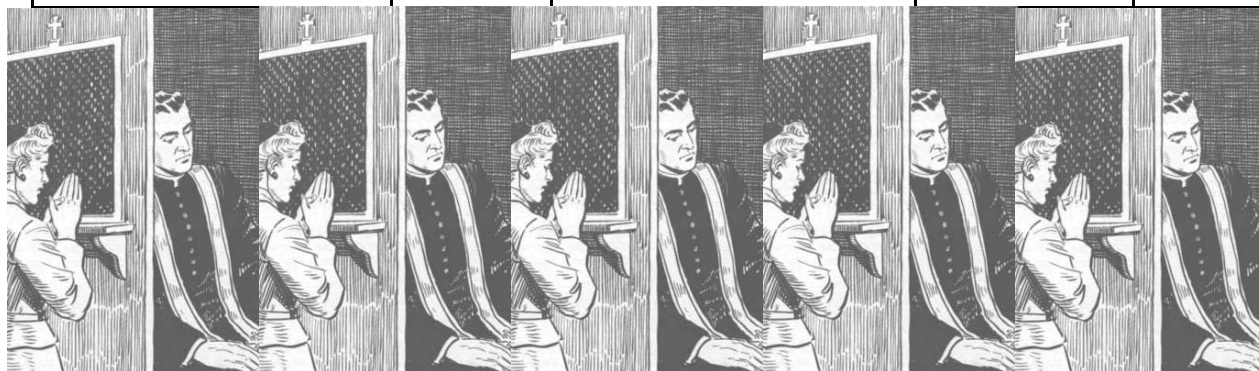

Pax et Bonum!

Back around the same time he was inventing the Christmas crèche (1223) Saint Francis of Assisi was using this phrase to open every sermon and close every letter. "Pax et bonum" became the traditional Franciscan "hello" or "goodbye" expression. Translated from the Latin, it reads "peace and all goodness [be with you]."

In this age of secularism I have found the phrase a handy and even clever response to those who insist on saying "Happy Holidays." It keeps the ball in our court as people who recognize the Latin are forced to deal mentally with *religious* stuff and people ignorant of Latin who ask "what's that all about?" are treated to an explanation of St. Francis' Christmas lore.

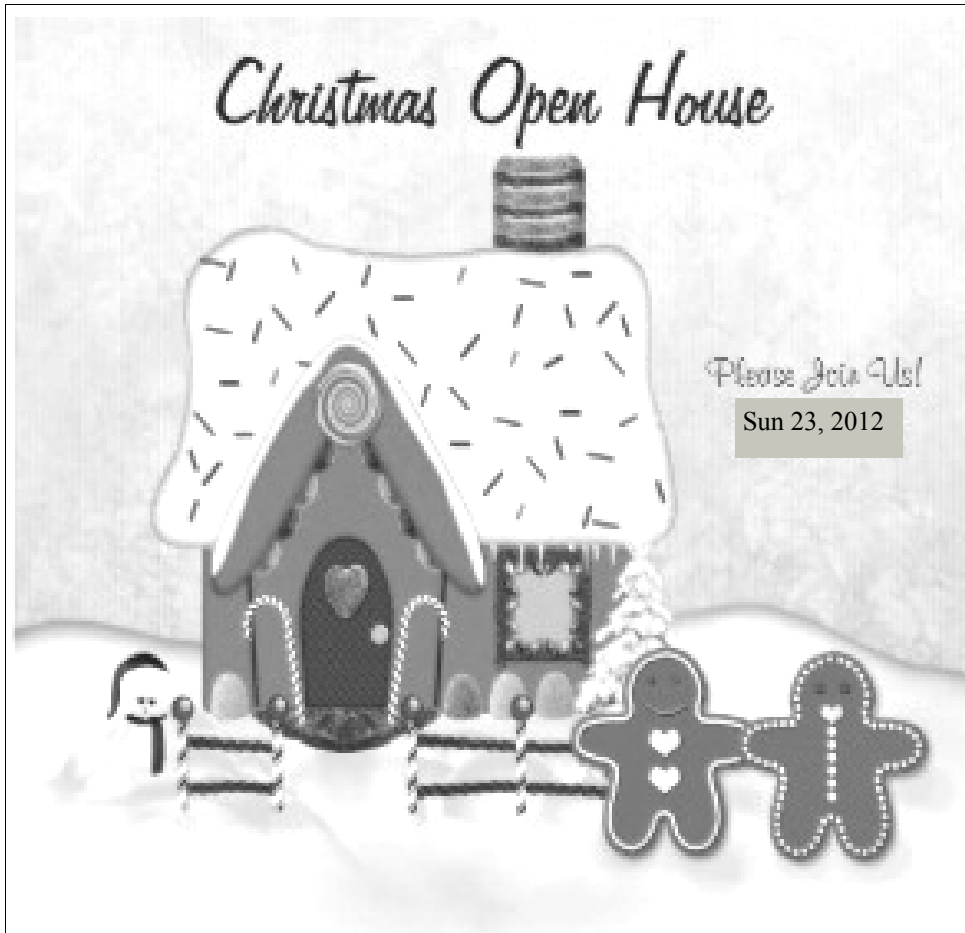

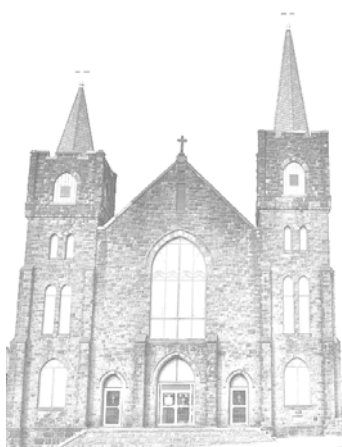
