## Christmas and New Year Schedules *and Notes:* Masses Continued:

It isn't the New Year which makes January 1, a Holy Day of Obligation. It's because the Church celebrates the Feast of Mary, the Holy Mother of God on January 1, which makes it a Holy Day of Obligation. And so, Masses of obligation will be Celebrated (with less fan-fair then the preceding week) at **4:30 P.M. on Tuesday** (New Years' Eve) and **10:00 A.M on Wednesday** (New Years' Day.)

**Note Well:** Both Holy Days are identical, time-wise. Evening Masses at 4:30 P.M. and Day Masses at 10:00 A.M. Unlike Sunday's there is only one Mass on the Holy Days themselves.

Concerning Decoration: Some good folks, about whom, more, later, are doing the heavy lifting for us this year on the 18th or 19th, leaving for us the fun stuff of decorating an already positioned tree, deciding where and how the Nativity scene should appear and devouring the pizza in the vestibule.
