A simpler explanation of a complicated and sometimes confusing issue concerning Baptism. It was a Jewish belief that baptism in the waters of the river Jordan made (in some sense) men Holy. When the all Holy man Jesus was baptized by John He made the water of the river Jordan Holy. It's kind of a restatement of what happened at Jesus' Nativity. His birth changed the birth of all men (and Women) what was ordinary became Holy.

Is this where Jesus "instituted" the Sacrament of Baptism? Well, yes and no. It would take a whole book to explain the subtle differences. Just remember that the water didn't make Jesus the - man - holy like in sacramental baptism but the Holy man Jesus made the water holy.
