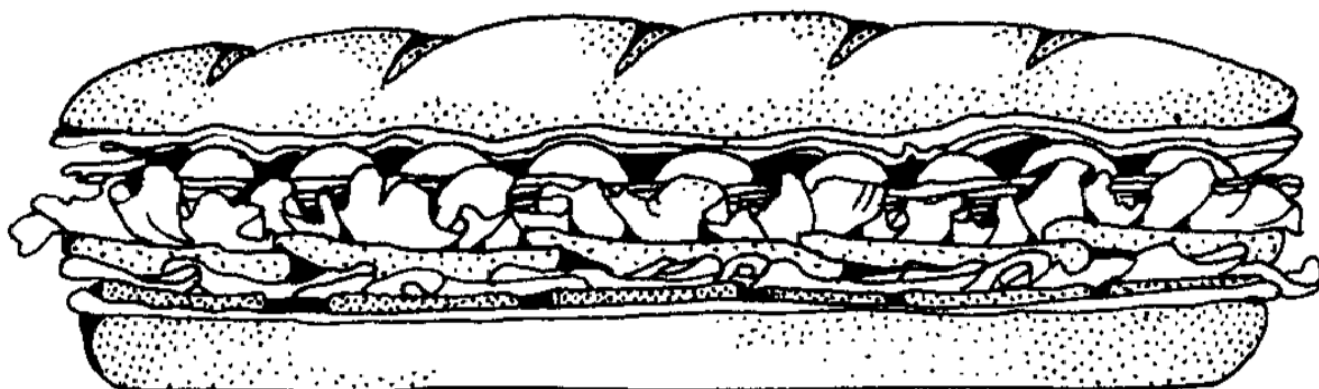

"Let's see if we can't get new carpeting in the vestibule and down the aisles of the Church to complete our interior renovations," he says. "We should be able to do that for under five thousand."
