


This year the theme is Follow Me-the Words "Follow Me" invite us into a deeper relationship with Jesus as we share in His mission to love and serve.

This year's Baby Bottle Campaign for Precious Life, Inc. began on Mother's Day, May 11, and continues until Father's Day, June 15. Please be supportive.


