Save this particular issue of the **Fatima Mirror** for home study and for future use on those occasions when you participate in the Holy Mass celebrated according to the Extraordinary Form, the Traditional Latin Mass. Some will remember what follows as the prayers at the foot of the altar. This *dialogue* was originally intended to take place between the priest and the altar boy(s) who were there to represent the people in the pews. Then on September 3, 1958 the Vatican issued a decree which said among other things, "A higher degree of participation is achieved when the entire congregation recites [in Latin] the responses appointed for the server at low Mass." The document makes it clear that this is permissible but not essential. So, anyone may, but nobody has to, respond with or in place of the altar boy(s).
