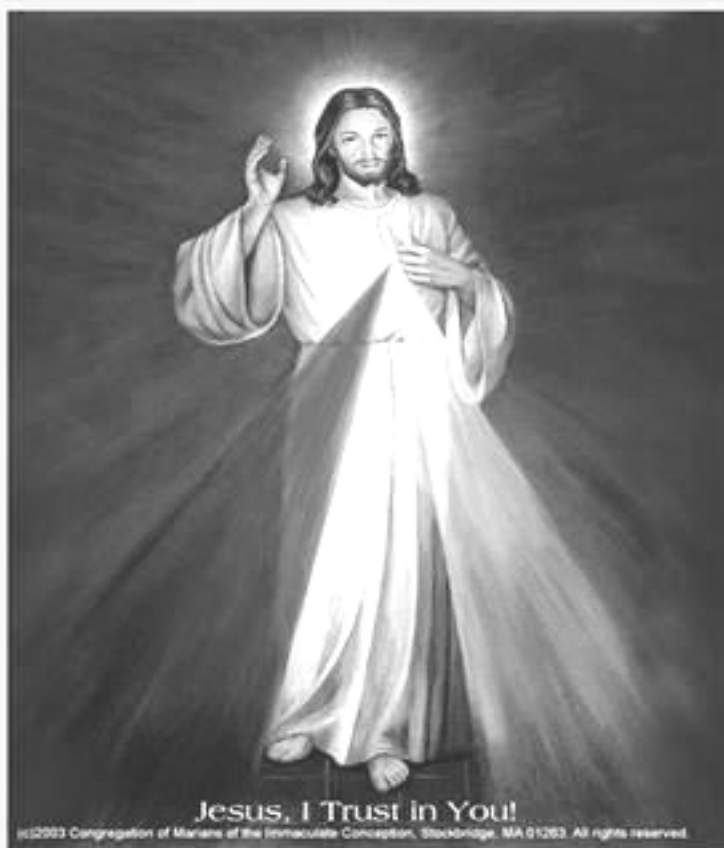

In and out of consciousness I do remember wondering why they were not doing medical stuff during my ten minute grace period, especially because I didn't feel any different than I had since they put me in the ambulance. I wondered what was going on while I was in that goofy state of suspended animation.

Several people told me later they were praying the Divine Mercy Chaplet ... for me. Weeks after I was relating my bout with Septicemia to my friend, funeral director, Bob Jones, who with characteristic composure said, "that's funny, I usually get all of those."

All that makes sense and is consistent with what we read about this super prayer. More and more of us better and better understand with regard to this devotion to the Divine Mercy that old Jewish proverb, "for those who have Faith no explanation is necessary, for those who don't, none is possible. Saint Faustina, pray for us.

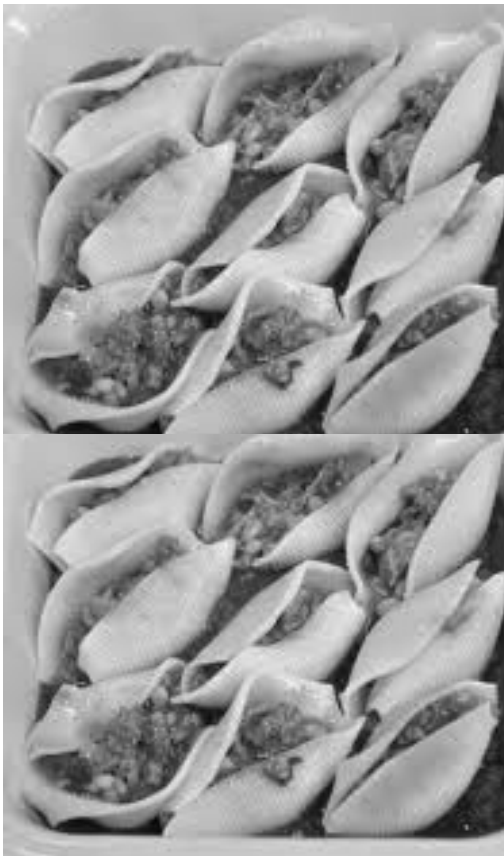
