- A \$2,500.00 gift given to the parish for the purpose of sidewalk repair, plus lots of volunteer labor will enable the parish to repair or replace the number of cement pads which are either broken or misaligned as well as the crumbling curbing in front of the church all of which are posing health hazards and insurance risks. The work should begin by the end of the month.


