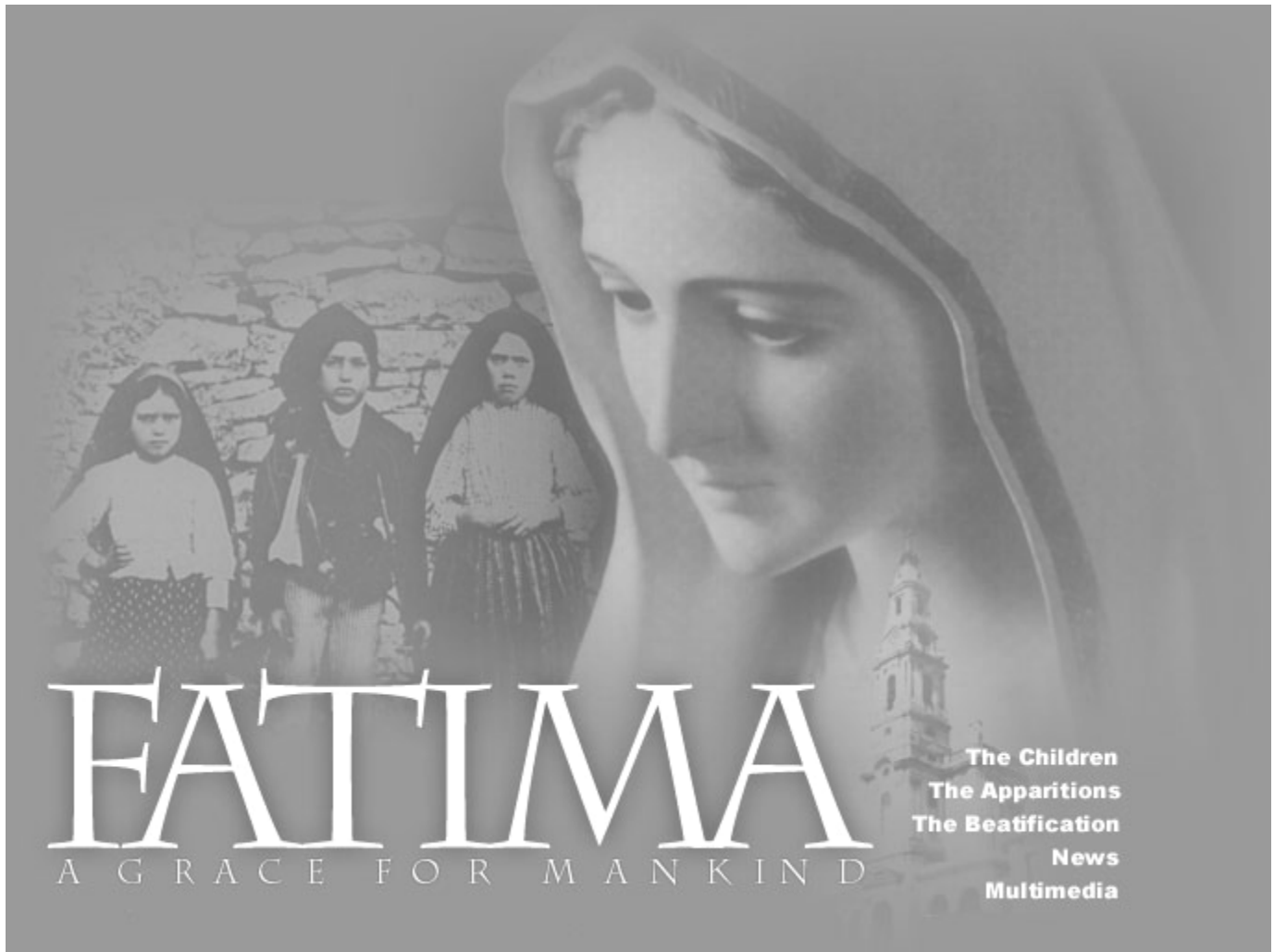

This is a very special week for devotees of Jesus' Mother. She is FIRST among all the Saints. This week we focus on two extreme features of Mary's existence. Thursday we acknowledge and celebrate her ability to move freely around the celestial regions in a manner no other heavenly beings can, except of course, members of the Trinity. Mary is the perfect human being. She is perfectly comfortable communicating on the human level (Fatima et al) while at the same time utilizing her Assumed body and soul to affect and even effect divine strategies.
