The publication of the third edition of the ROMAN MISSAL was officially promulgated in Rome in March 2002. Confirmation of the United States Catholic Conference of Bishops' adaptations to the revised General Instruction of the Roman Missal arrived in April 2002. Even though there is presently no English translation of the ROMAN MISSAL, the Catholic world implemented the revised Missal along with adaptations particular to each country in 2002.
