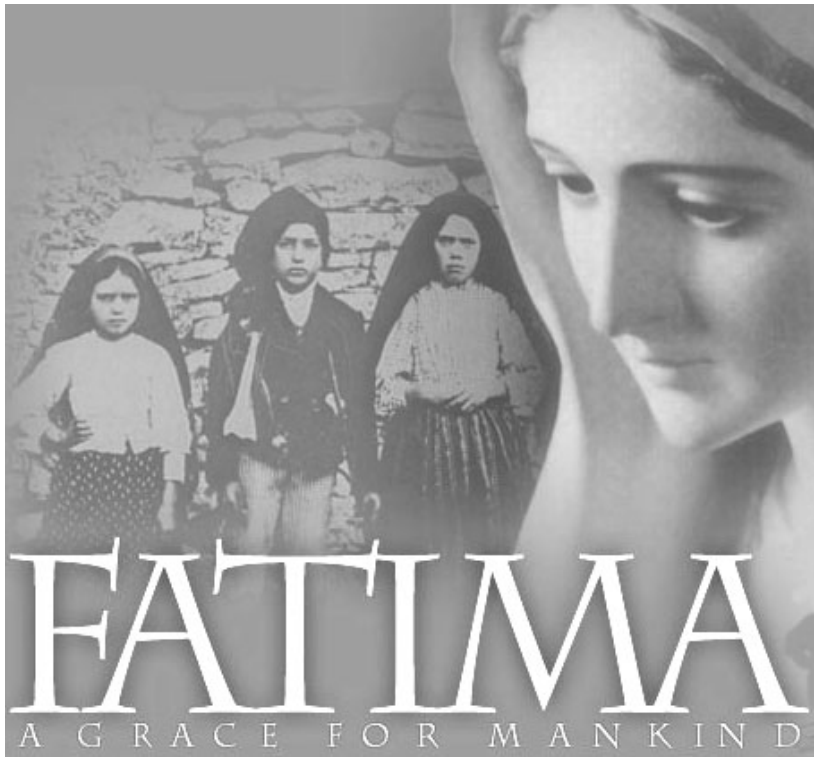

On July 13, 1917 the following happened near the holm-oak tree. Mary said: "Make sacrifices for sinners, and say often, especially while making a sacrifice: O Jesus, this is for the love of Thee, for the conversion of sinners, and in reparation for offences committed against the Immaculate Heart of Mary."

Lucia writes; "As Our lady spoke these words she opened her hands once more, as she had during the two previous months. The rays of light seemed to penetrate the earth, and we saw as it were a sea of fire. Plunged in this fire were demons and souls in human form, like transparent burning embers, all blackened or burnished bronze, floating about in the conflagration, now raised into the air by the flames that issued from within themselves together with great clouds of smoke, now following back on every side like sparks in huge fires, without weight or equilibrium, amid shrieks and groans of pain and despair, which horrified us and made us tremble with fear. (It must have been this sight which caused me to cry out, as people say they heard me do). The demons could be distinguished by their terrifying sad repellent likeness to frightful and unknown animals, black and transparent like burning coals. Terrified and as if to plead for succor, we looked up at Our Lady, who said to us, so kindly and so sadly: You have seen hell, where the souls of poor sinners go.

When you pray the Rosary, say after each mystery: O my Jesus, forgive us, save us from the fire of hell. Lead all souls to heaven, especially those who are most in need."

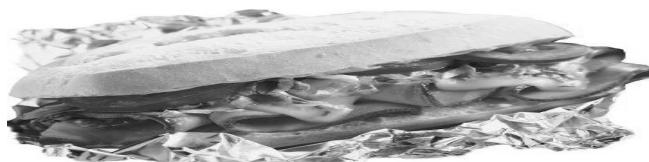
Mike Sweeney
