

## PRAY FOR OUR PRIESTS



**August 4**, is the official feast day of St. John Vianney, universally known as the "Cure of Ars." St. John Mary Batiste Vianney is the patron saint of all Diocesan priests. St. John has been a "favorite" of Our Lady of Fatima parish ever since the John Kasun, Sr. family presented our community with a nearly life-sized statue of the beloved Saint in commemoration of John's deceased wife, Frances. Father Zatalava has been fostering special devotion to the Saint in a variety of ways since the parish received the beautiful memorial. This year (2013) he has designated in his parish Sunday, August 4, (which is also the 18<sup>th</sup> Sunday in Ordinary Time) as a special afternoon of robust and intensive prayer for the distressed and hurting priests of our Dioceses. All Altoona Johnstown diocesan priests confronting physical, mental, emotional, spiritual, legal, Canonical, or Vocational issues will be the objects of this afternoon of prayer.

Because we wish to offer spiritual comfort and support for all our priests whether they suffer in lonely silence or in public scrutiny we think it only fair that we not identify particular persons or situations. We will be praying for those whom nobody knows as well as those whom everybody knows.

Our Lady of Fatima Parish extends to all the people of the Altoona-Johnstown Diocese a sincere invitation to participate in all or some of this special afternoon of prayer according to the plan below.
