### The Most Holy Trinity

Neither the term nor the concept "Trinity" appears in the New Testament. Our scriptures do name all three persons and describe some sort of unity of relationship among them, but it remained for following centuries to wrestle with this self-revelation of God. The term "Trinity" appeared about two hundred years into the Catholic Church's existence, as it began to gain a hold and there was more time to reflect upon a more precise understanding. One way the church began to understand the relationship of the persons of the Trinity was through the term "procession." The three persons of the Trinity live in mutual indwelling with each other, and are revealed to people this way. Thus the Son became known through the procession called "filiation" and the Spirit through the procession called "spiration."

### **Code of Canon Law**

**Can. 396 §1. A bishop is obliged to visit the diocese annually either in whole or in part, so that he visits the entire diocese at least every Five years either personally or, if he has been legitimately impeded, through the coadjutor bishop, an auxiliary, vicar general, Episcopal vicar, or another presbyter.**

§2. A bishop is permitted to choose the clerics he prefers as companions and assistants on a visitation; any contrary privilege or custom is reprobated.

**Can. 397 §1. Persons, Catholic institutions, and sacred things and places, which are located within the area of the diocese, are subject to ordinary Episcopal visitation.**

§2. A bishop can visit members of religious institutes of pontifical right and their houses only in the cases expressed in law.

**Can. 398** A bishop is to strive to complete the pastoral visitation with due diligence. He is to take care that he does not burden or impose a hardship on anyone through unnecessary expenses.

Bishop Joseph will make his Episcopal Visitation at Our Lady of Fatima Parish on Saturday, July 25, 2009. He will preside at the 4:30 Evening Mass. Immediately following the Mass, while all remain in the Church, he will conduct a "town hall" type Question and Answer session, during which he will probably ask as many wide ranging questions as he is asked. It is important to note that even though Canon Law requires this Visitation, Bishop Joseph was most gracious in accommodating his schedule to our parish schedule. Please do likewise with your personal schedules.
