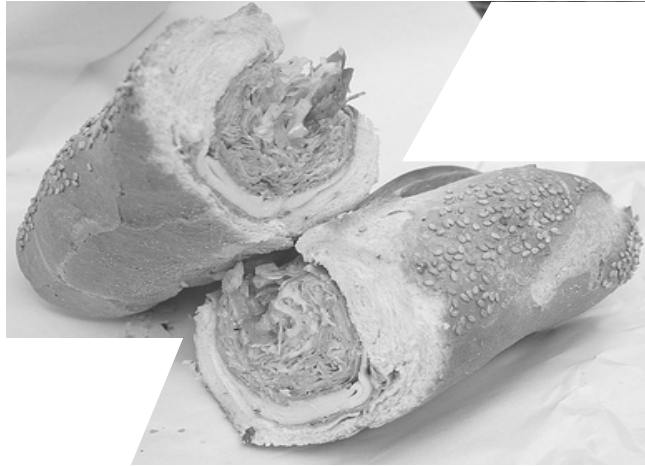

Prayer In Defense of Marriage

The grace of Jesus flowed forth at Cana at the request of the Blessed Mother. May your Son, through the intercession of Mary, pour out upon us a new measure of the Gifts of the Holy Spirit as we join with all people of good will to promote and protect the unique beauty of marriage.

May your Holy Spirit enlighten our society to treasure the heroic love of husband and wife, and guide our leaders to sustain and protect the singular place of mothers and fathers in the lives of their children.

Father, we ask that our prayers be joined to those of the Virgin Mary, that your Word may transform our service so as to safeguard the incomparable splendor of marriage.

We ask all these things through Christ our Lord, Amen.

Concerning Straight Marriage and [so called] Gay Marriage THE BIBLE SAYS

Genesis 1-27 “ God created man in his image; in the divine image he created him; male and female he created them.”

Genesis 2:21-24, “So the Lord God cast a sleep on the man, and while he was asleep, he took out one of his ribs and closed up its place with flesh.. The Lord then built up into a woman the rib that he had taken from the man. When he brought her to the man, the man said, “this one, at last, is bone of my bones and flesh of my flesh; This one shall be called woman , for out of her man this one has been taken.” That is why a man leaves his father and mother and clings to his wife, and the two of them become one body.”

Leviticus 18-22 refers to the sanctity of sex. “ you shall not lie with a male as with a woman, such a thing is an abomination”.

If the Old Testament isn't convincing enough let's explore the New Testament. In Romans 1-26 St. Paul writes, “ Therefore, God handed them over to degrading passions. Their females exchanged natural relations for unnatural, 27, and the males likewise gave up natural relations with females and burned with lust for one another. Males did shameful things with males and thus received in their own persons the due penalty for their perversity.”

St. Paul further states in 1-Corinthians 6-9 “Do you not know that the unjust will not inherit the kingdom of God? Do not be deceived; neither fornicators nor idolaters nor adulterers nor boy prostitutes nor practicing homosexuals...will inherit the kingdom of God.”

In 1-Timothy 1:8-10 St. Paul warns those who engage in such acts are called sinners. “ We know that the law is good, provided that one uses it as law, with the understanding that law is meant not for a righteous person but for the lawless and unruly, the godless and sinful, the unholy and profane, those who kill their fathers or mothers, murderers, the unchaste, practicing homosexuals, kidnappers, liars, perjurers and whatever else is opposed to sound teaching.”

In addition four very distinct verses on matrimony, Mathew 19: 5-6, . two become one flesh. Mathew 10:7-12, ...what God has joined together let no man separate. Ephesians 5:22-32, that marriage is a union of man and wife in the image of Christ and the Church. Finally, Hebrews 13:4, let marriage be honored by all.
