**May 9-10, 2009**

The Catechism of the Catholic Church tells us that: "the laity are made to share in the priestly, prophetic, and kingly office of Christ; they have therefore, in the Church and in the world, their **own assignment in the mission of the whole People of God.**"

In what the legend on Bishop Joseph's Coat-of-Arms describes as the "Household of God," the Diocese of Altoona-Johnstown has an annual drive called the Annual Catholic Appeal. Notice we don't call it the Annual Bishop's Collection or even the Annual Diocesan Appeal. We, who make up the Diocese of Altoona-Johnstown, understand that in these eight counties of Pennsylvania, the Church Christ founded subsists in the Catholic population.
