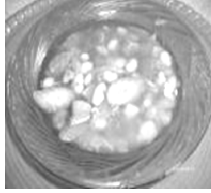
There are 1.37 Million (1996) abortions per year.

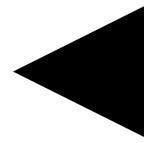
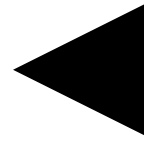
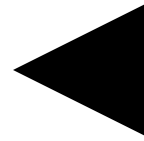
